Welcome

Hello and welcome to our 14th on farm production sale, we are very pleased with what's on offer this year and feel that the sheep and cattle available will compliment any livestock system.

We have utmost confidence in our genetics, they are tried and tested in a commercial environment without excessive feeding which enables us to grow our stock at a sensible pace. Sale sheep receive no concentrates and are outwintered on grass and forage crops whilst bulls are also wintered outside on a forage ration which includes a little home grown cereals.

Bulling periods have been cut to seven weeks for cows and six weeks for heifers whilst on the sheep side of our operation stud ewes get 28 days with the ram whilst commercial ewes and hoggs get 25 and 21 days respectively.

Whilst we are delighted with the performance of our stud flocks, a real highlight over the past year has been our commercial gimmers, which are at the cutting edge of our breeding program.

These sheep are a three way cross between homebred Texel, Aberfield and Romney and when mated to our own Suffolk rams produce an excellent lamb which sells easily whether prime or store. They scanned at 188% and lambed outdoors with minimal intervention, just the sort of sheep we want to breed for our commercial operation.

Our team have again gone above and beyond to make this sale happen, of course its many months in the making but in the past month its been especially full on.

Special mention to Lexie for pulling the catalogue together and being extremely patient with the stock team extracting details of what's actually for sale or getting content written by Dad hasn't always been easy.

From a family perspective whilst we do have our moments, working together as a team spanning three generations is pretty special, all of our children are now actively involved in the business and with Mum and Dad still on hand this summer has been awesome.

Off farm we are renovating a nearby hotel which in years to come will be able to host a suitable sale after party under its new name of 'Shore'. We look forward to welcoming you there once its complete but in the meantime please enjoy the hospitality on sale day we will have local beer, Quintin from Storehouse back with his Land Rover pizzas and Black Isle Dairy Ice Cream!



Sale Format

The sale will be conducted as a Helmsman-style auction, meaning that all lots are for sale simultaneously.

The sale will be hosted via our Yourbid platform, accessed via our website - www.fearnfarm.com.
Once registered, online buyers will receive a buyer number via email which will automatically accompany each bid placed. All live bids will be visible at all times online.

The sale will commence in the usual way via Yourbid on 23rd August culminating on Friday 29th August both online and on farm with bulls and gimmers first at 2pm then Texels, Beltex, Beltex X Texel, Suffolks and SuffolkX at 3pm and finally Romneys, Romtex and Aberfields at 4pm. Once there has been a period of at least two minutes without a bid being received on any lot.

If another bid is placed on any lot during the two-minute period, then time is extended, where bidding is open on all lots. Final time will be called clearly and discretion will be used to ensure all buyers are satisfied.

We would encourage all buyers to register 24 hours in advance of the conclusion of the sale and place practice bids on our demonstration lots ahead of the sale day, by doing this you will allow us to support you with any technical issue which we don't envisage but best to be prepared.

Viewing

On sale day livestock will be available for viewing from 11am with food and refreshments available.

Prior to the sale, all lots will be filmed and photographed for you to view online. If you would like to physically view the stock prior to the sale, please contact John or James to arrange an appointment.

We also have an open day in conjunction with the Beef Shorthorn cattle society on August 16th, sale stock will be on view that day.

Post Sale

Invoices will be emailed direct from Fearn Farm and all sheep movements will be made via Scot EID by us.

We anticipate that some people will collect their purchases on the day of the sale whilst others may want to defer collection until transport can be arranged, please discuss this with John or James.

We can deliver locally and we'll work with hauliers to arrange delivery further afield.

All purchases to be settled before removal of stock from Fearn Farm if not previously arranged with John or Fiona Scott.

Any party successfully bidding on a lot will be deemed to be liable for that account.

Bulls will be sold under NBA rules, with a 6 month breeding warranty given from the date on which animals leave Fearn

Warranty

All Rams have been vet checked prior to the sale, we have done what we can to ensure they are fit for purpose. If you have any issues with your purchase post sale that means the ram is incapable of doing his job please get in touch, we are happy to help. All Bulls have been inspected and fertility tested recently by Kenny from Scot Vet.

Health Status

All rams and gimmers offered for sale are MV accredited and are on the heptivac P system.

They have recently received the following treatments:

- · Ovivac P booster
- · Agrimin 24-7 Bolus
- · Braxvoxin 10

And prior to departure they will receive the following to allow them to enter your quarantine area:

- · Cydectin 2% LA solution
- · Zolvix





<u>Understanding the breedplan performance</u> <u>recording information in this catalogue</u>

Only Beef Shorthorn GROUP BREEDPLAN EBVs or INTERIM EBVs with Accuracy (Acc) can be validly compared between herds.

ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES (EBVS)

The EBV is the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait.

ACCURACY

An accuracy value is presented with every EBV and gives an indication of the amount of information that has been used in the calculation of that EBV. The higher the accuracy the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal or it's relatives. Accuracy below 75% should be considered low.

CALVING EASE

Calving Ease EBVs are based on calving difficulty scores, birth weights and gestation length information. More positive EBVs are favourable and indicate easier calving.

DIR: Direct calving ease indicates how this animal influences the birth of its progeny.

DTRS: Daughter's calving ease indicates how well the animal produces daughters that have easier calving.

BIRTH AND FERTILITY

GL: Gestation Length EBV (days) is based on AI records. Lower (negative) GL EBVs indicate shorter gestation lengths which generally relate to easier calving and increased growth after birth.

BWT: Birth Weight EBV (kg) is based on the measured birth weight of animals, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

SS: Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is an indicator of male fertility in regards to semen quality and quantity. Higher (positive) EBVs indicate higher fertility. There is also a small negative correlation with age of puberty in female progeny.

GROWTH

MILK: 200-Day Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV is indicative of their daughter's milking ability as it affects the 200-day weight of their calves.

200: 200-Day Growth EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of animals taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to early ages.

400: 400-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600: 600-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

CARCASE

CWT: Carcase Weight EBV (kg) estimates the genetic difference in carcase weight at a standard age of 650 days.

EMA: Eye Muscle Area EBV (cm2) estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area of a 300kg dressed carcase. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals.

FAT: Rib Fat EBV (mm) estimates the genetic differences in fat depth at the rib in a 300kg dressed carcase. More positive EBVs indicate more subcutaneous fat and earlier maturity.

RBY%: Retail Beef Yield Percent EBV (%) represents total (boned out) meat yield as a percentage of a 300kg dressed carcase. A more positive EBV indicates higher percentage yield for the 300kg carcase size...

IMF%: Intra-muscular Fat Percent EBV (%) is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of ntra-muscular fat at the 12/13th rib site in a 300kg carcase. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Terminal index

The Shorthorn Terminal index is aimed at a commercial herd using Shorthorn bulls over dairy cross cows to breed steers and heifers to turn off at 19 months of age. All progeny are destined for slaughter and no replacement females are selected from within the herd. There is some emphasis on calving ease while finishing steers at around 580 kg live weight (310 kg carcase weight) using a pasture based production system.

Use this index in a commercial herd to produce progeny for slaughter. The index has moderate emphasis on easier calving (ie getting a live calf with minimal human interference) while producing calves that will then grow quickly to market specifications at around 19 months of age. The index is focused on slaughter animals and does not account for maternal traits and is therefore not suited to breeding replacement females.

If you are using smaller framed cows or heifers in your herd, then you should also put extra emphasis on a higher Calving Ease Direct EBV when selecting a sire using this index.

Self Replacing index - The Shorthorn Self Replacing index is aimed at a Shorthorn herd selecting replacement females from within the herd while breeding steers and excess heifers to turn off at 19 months of age. There is emphasis on calving ease and maternal traits while also looking to finish steers for slaughter at around 580 kg live weight (310 kg carcase weight) using a pasture based production system supplemented with extra rations during the finishing phase.

This Self Replacing index is also suitable to using Shorthorn sires over mixed breed cows where replacement females are sourced from within the herd. There may be some hybrid vigour expressed in the progeny depending on the breed type of the cows used. Therefore you should consider placing extra emphasis on the Calving Ease EBVs (more positive) of the sire to allow for possible heavier birth weights of his calves due to hybrid vigour.

Use this index in both commercial and pedigree herds where you are balancing the requirements of selecting replacement females while also producing animals for slaughter.

Maternal Index - The Maternal Index is designed for a commercial Beef Shorthorn cross herd that is focused on breeding herd replacements and on weaning as many and as heavy calves as possible at 8 months of age. It estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow mated, for an example Beef Shorthorn Euro cross commercial cow herd targeting the production of pasture grown calves. Steers and heifers are weaned and marketed at an average of 350kg live weight at 8 months of age for further finishing or as replacement heifers.
