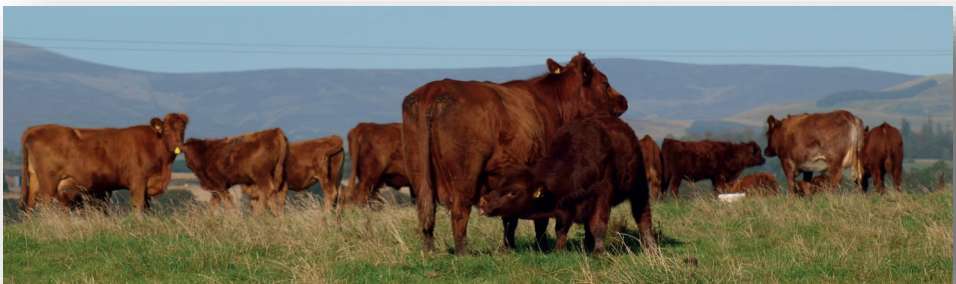

The Incheoch **SIMMENTAL** herd of 50 - mostly polled - cows is based on the most functional cow families from the previous 'Dirnanean' herd. Calving ease, structural soundness for longevity and a calm, maternal character have always been a priority—we've turned up the pressure on lower mature weight, ease of fleshing and fertility in order to find you sires that will leave lower maintenance, regular calving, long lasting daughters ...and a steer with do-ability and a good top.

Inchisla **ANGUS** are bred to provide a short-gestation, calving-ease sire and leave easy-finished grass-type cattle. Clare has produced us bulls particularly suited to go to yearling heifers, which have left calves with performance hard to fault.

The Dirnanean **LUING** cows have been the backbone of our business for 50 years. Fertile, hardy, easy to manage, fleshing ability from 2nd quality forage, and a temperament that makes working with cattle a pleasure. Our pure Luing steers can put a lot of weight on at grass and finish before their second winter—if you are visiting, make sure to have a look at them. More cattlemen are turning to the Luing bull for an injection of no-nonsense cow-traits into their herd.

“Robust bulls, bred from Functional, Efficient cows has been our goal for many years now. We run just over 200 pedigree, performance recorded cows, and select hard for fertility, structural soundness, good temperaments and easy calving. We find that easy-fleshed, medium framed cattle with a bit of maternal character tend to be the ones who tick the boxes—and we think the bulls we have on offer today can transfer these traits to your herd.

These bulls were not creep fed, had paddock exercise through the winter and have been summered at grass. Our non-intensive system of developing bulls lets you pick out the ones that can put on flesh from forage.

This group of bulls have been halter broken but not led, their feet are shown untrimmed and were semen tested on 14th August.

Terms & Conditions

- Bidding in £ pounds.
- Sale held with Pentland Auctions, invoice emailed by Messrs Finlay McGowan, with payment terms 30 days or before uplift.
- Bulls will be sold with the usual breeding warranty given.
- Bulls have been successfully semen tested. Results available.
- Collection: we don't expect bulls to be uplifted on sale day
 - Bulls nose-rung before collection unless requested.
 - We will try to help delivery where possible.
- All stock can be left at Incheoch, at our risk, until the end of September.

Herd Health

The health and fertility of the Incheoch herd has always been a priority, being the bedrock of profitable cattle production. As well as controlling the 'Health scheme' diseases, the herd has enjoyed general good health and excellent fertility. Respiratory disease and scours, along with most of the common cattle ailments are rare at Incheoch and antibiotic use is minimal.

Johnes Disease: The herd is a member of the Premium Cattle Health Scheme run by SAC and has been pro-actively engaged in controlling Johnes Disease, over and above the requirements of the scheme, for 28 years. There have been no clinical cases within the herd for many years. A single positive result last year has put the herd at a risk level 3. In the last 11 years a total of 2390 individual blood tests have been carried out with only 7 positives. None of the animals presented for sale have a history of Johnes in their families.

BVD: The herd has been fully accredited for 20 years and is additionally vaccinated. All animals presented for sale are individually vaccinated and accredited.

Leptospirosis: There is no history of this disease in the herd and it is now policy not to vaccinate the breeding herd, but sale animals have been vaccinated.

IBR: The breeding herd is vaccinated, believed IBR free though not accredited. Bulls are not vaccinated prior to sale but this can be arranged prior to collection if they are not going to an IBR free herd

Bluetongue Vaccine

All bulls vaccinated with Syvazul BTV3 20/8/26, 2nd jag due 10th Sept—to stay on-farm until then.

Accuracy represents the reliability of the EBV prediction—it reflects the amount of data that has been gathered on the individual and the members of it's family. Over 70% would give a high 'confidence level' in the EBV (often only achieved with progeny measured), and lower than 30% would be low confidence.

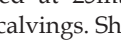

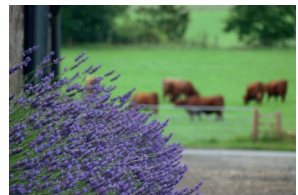

If you visit this year, you will find us at the start of rebuilding a facility that is primarily designed to develop bull calves into healthy, active, performance-tested young sires—as well as being a comfortable sale venue.

In the meantime, rest assured, the old stable that has become the hospitality shed is still intact and we hope to offer you a warm welcome there on the 8th, and for many years to come.



Bull Nutrition

Bull fertility and longevity have always been the key focus for us here at Incheoch and our approach to nutrition is designed to support that.

We've worked with Harbro for a number of years now; they understand what we're trying to achieve and design rations that make the best of what we grow on farm, combined with a few key quality products that fit our system.

Together we have come up with some diet parameters —minimum 50% forage on a DM basis, and maximum 20% Starch for bull rations.

The bulls on offer today have a steady life-time growth pattern of around 1.5 kgs per day.

- There is no creep feed, so that maternal ability can be properly gauged.
- Milk, Grass, Grass-silage and Grass again have been the basis of their diet.
- Supplements in first winter were bruised oats, distiller's grains and 1 kg of Harbro Stockman's Choice growing pellet
- Supplement this summer has been 2 kg/d of Stockman's Choice growing pellets.

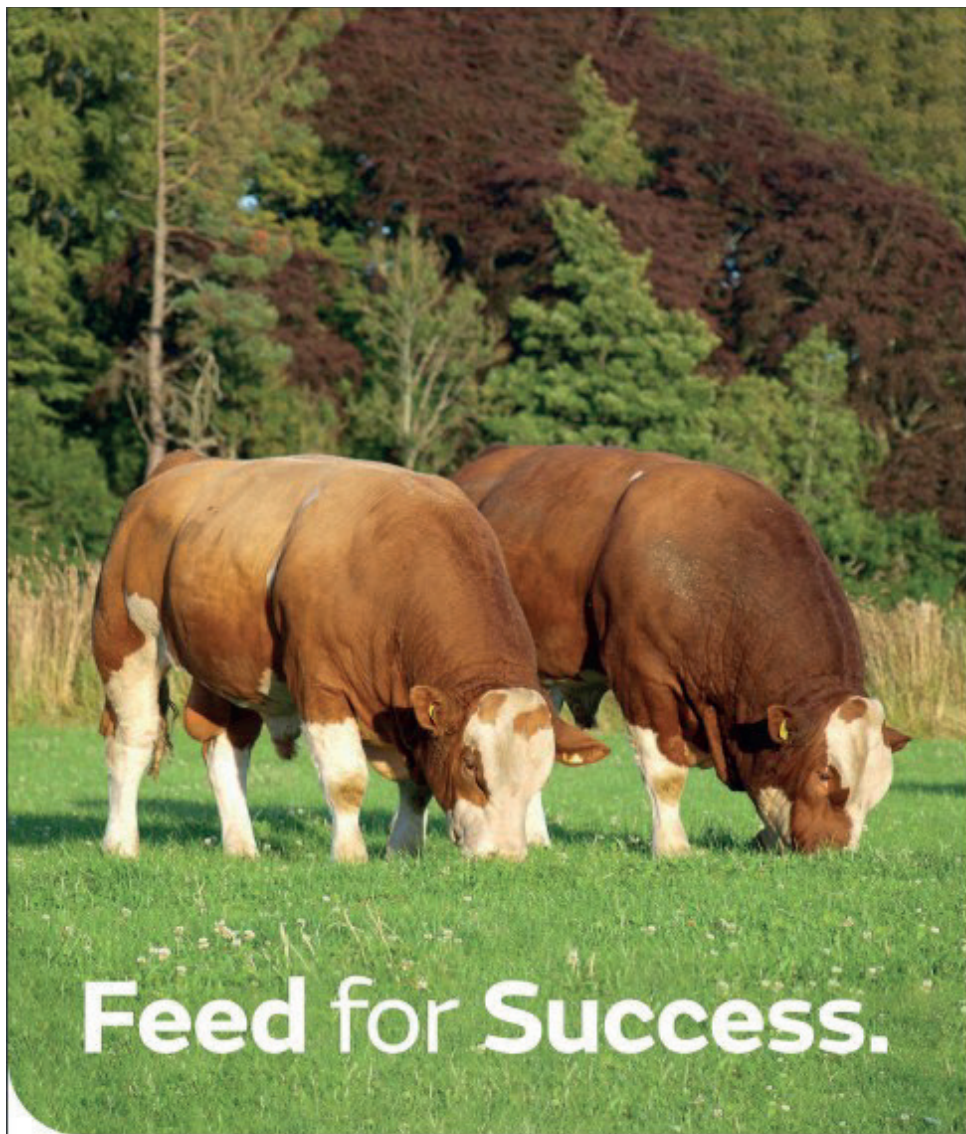


Wintering Option Available

It's fairly easy to winter a young bull to be fit to go to cows as a 2yo — it's another thing having him in sale condition, with a coat of hair and a layer of fat. Help us treat your young herd-sire's rumen and liver with care and buy early.

We can keep your bull at Incheoch until you are ready to take him, free of charge until the end of September, or further through the winter on a feed cost only. Keep payable at uplift at £25/week. Bulls will be looked after to the best of our ability and will remain at our risk when here. All bulls must be collected by end Feb.

Or why not get him home to acclimatise, maybe give him a turn with some cull cows and get him used to the farm? It's good forward planning to have a tested, farm-fit 2-year-old bull secured and ready for the breeding season.
